



PARENTAL STANDARDS AGREEMENT

At Union Karate Do we take our responsibility to safeguard your child seriously and their welfare is our number one priority. Accordingly, we ask all parents to ensure they follow our parental standards agreement, as set out below. Failure to do so may result in us having to ask you or your child(ren) to leave the club.

As a parent or carer of a child at Union Karate Do I/we agree that we will;

1. Act with respect and integrity when in the club setting also to minimize talking and disruptive behavior during the class.
2. Follow the instructions of the instructor(s) and/or other team members to help classes run safely and smoothly.
3. Drop off and pick up our child in good time and as agreed.
4. Respond to digital communications where appropriate from the club, including correspondence on club membership and any relevant medical declarations.
5. Keep the club updated if any medical conditions, medication or injuries should become relevant.
6. Discuss concerns or complaints we may have with the lead instructor as soon as possible.
7. Do all we can to keep all club members safe.
8. Ensure any younger siblings or children in your care are not disruptive or causing any dangers in the training environment.
9. Any borrowed equipment is returned to Union Karate Do as it was leant and that it is used correctly
10. When helping students of Union Karate Do (Early Years Class) to follow the instructions of the instructor(s) and/or other team members to help classes run safely and smoothly.
11. If your child has been disruptive during a class to work with the instructor(s) and/or other team members to find a positive solution to improve their behavior.
