



UNION KARATE DO SUBSCRIPTION POLICY

We strive to keep our prices low to allow all members of the community to train and thrive together as a Martial Arts School. We put a lot of the money raised back into the club and our charity Active Martial Arts North Devon CIC.

Your payment details will be held securely by the company Stripe and will not pass to a third party. UKD is registered with the "ICO" – (Information Commissioner's Office.)

Here are the current payment and subscription plans that are in place.

- 1 class is £8.00 per Session (Pay as you Go)
- 35 classes a Year £20 a Month (Roughly Once a Week, Save £40.00 per Year)
- 70 classes a Year £30 a Month (Roughly Twice a Week, Save £80.00 per Year)

Union Karate Do monthly subscription cost for adult or child's training and tuition will be collected at the beginning of each month. Your Subscription may be cancelled at any time provided no invoices are outstanding there will be no additional cancelation fees added. We just require 48 hours' notice to cancel your payment of the subscription. On signing there is a cooling off period of fourteen days should you decide not to proceed with the payment plan. The subscription plan is 12 payments over a period of 12 months and not based on how many classes attended in a month.

- During School Half-Terms and Holidays there will be NO classes, although special events may be running at an additional cost.
- Any classes missed due to sickness or holidays; the student may attend other dojos for catch up classes at NO additional cost.
- Your normal Subscription Fee does not include Gradings, Summer Camps, Seminars and other events that Union Karate Do may host.
- If you cancel your subscription at any time there will be a £10 fee to set up a new payment plan. The subscription plan creates a hugely reduced rate in training fees to the pay as you go system.
- The Subscription plan is an annual agreement therefore students cannot alternate the payment plan to pay as you go for interim periods without a £10 surcharge.
