





UNION KARATE DO SQUAD MEMBER POLICY

Union Karate Do aim to provide a safe and fair squad member programme for students aged 5 to 70 years of age. A normal Squad Member session will cost **£8**, or an extended Squad session will cost **£10**, and they will run once a month.

The stipulated criteria must be met as set out in the relevant guidance programme.

A student will not be able to become a squad member until factors considered by the instructor are met such as:

- Character of student (discipline, respect, dedication, and determination)
 - Length of time training (minimum of 1 year training)
- The age of the student and any underlying conditions (5 to 75 years of age)
 - Grade of Student (minimum of full red belt 10th Kyu)
- Must attempt to attend all the Union Karate Do squad training sessions (monthly)
- Students will be removed from the Squad if they miss more than 3 squad sessions in a row (unless absence is due to injury or family/ work commitments)

Current squad member fee is **FREE** (if successful) a squad member will be able to wear the squad member t-shirt and any other future squad member products.

An unsuccessful applicant may re-attempt to become a squad member at the next squad training session and another instructor review.

Essential Squad Member Equipment:

- Gum Shield £3
- Mitts (sparring Gloves) £15
- Shin and Instep Protectors £15
 - Squad Member Shirt £15
 - Squad Member Jacket £30
 - Squad Member Badge £5










The reward fist badges may be worn on the students karate gi showing recognition of their dedication to improving their own karate skills as a Union Karate Do Squad Member.
