#### 2. Profit Statement

Union Karate Do is not run as a commercial entity. While our income may be limited, any profits are reinvested into the club for the provision of equipment, training, and essential resources for instructors and staff.

# 3. Legal Registration

Union Karate Do is registered as a **Sole Trader**. UKD does work in partnership with **Active Martial Arts North Devon CIC**.

### 6. Insurance Provisions

Instructor Insurance



Union Karate Do ensure that all instructors are fully insured through **British Martial Arts & Boxing Association.** A copy of the relevant insurance documentation is available upon request or may be viewed at **https://bmaba.org.uk/**.

#### **Student Insurance**

We take our responsibility for safeguarding members seriously. All students are insured through **British Martial Arts & Boxing Association** for member-to-member liability. Cover is only applicable where a student has received an insurance or membership certificate from **British Martial Arts & Boxing Association**.

## 7. DBS Check Status

Union Karate Do provide training for adults and children, and therefore, all instructors hold an enhanced DBS check. Evidence of this can be provided upon request or verified at https://bmaba.org.uk/.

## 8. Instructor Grade Requirements

Union Karate Do ensure that our instructors meet the minimum qualification standards required by our governing association. This includes a minimum grade of **2nd Dan**.

#### 9. First Aid Status

We take health and safety seriously. All instructors are trained in first aid, and sufficient first aid equipment is present at all training sessions. A risk assessment is carried out before each class to ensure safety protocols are in place.

## 10. Professional Association Membership

Union Karate Do is a registered member of **British Martial Arts & Boxing Association**. Our membership number is **CLU7391/38215**, and this may be verified at any time at **https://bmaba.org.uk/**.

# 11. Fees and Charges

Union Karate Do maintain a transparent pricing structure with no hidden fees. All payments can be made via **Stripe** through our booking system **Smoothbook**, and receipts will be issued for all transactions.



The registration fee is £20, which includes association membership, insurance and licence booklet. This is payable after 4 weeks of training and is to be renewed annually.

- ✓ 1 CLASS IS £8 A SESSION (PAY AS YOU GO)
- ✓ **BRONZE**, **35** CLASSES A YEAR **£20** A MONTH (roughly once a week)
- ✓ **SILVER, 70** CLASSES A YEAR **£30** A MONTH (roughly twice a week)
- ✓ GOLD, 105 CLASSES A YEAR £40 A MONTH (roughly three times a week)

**Kyu** Gradings are **£20** per an application which includes certification and belt if successful.

**Dan** Gradings are £95 per an application which includes certification and belt if successful.

There is no binding contract, and students may discontinue training at any time.

# 12. Independence Status

Union Karate Do is affiliated with **British Martial Arts & Boxing Association**. to ensure high standards; however, we remain an independent entity. We comply with all applicable laws and regulations but are not subject to compulsory regulation by any single governing body.

# 13. Reporting Our Club

Martial arts in the UK does not have a single governing regulatory body. If you wish to raise concerns about Union Karate Do, please refer to our complaint's procedure first.
