





UNION KARATE DO GRADING POLICY

Union Karate Do aim to provide a safe and fair grading system for all our students.

The stipulated criteria must be met as set out in the relevant guidance programme.

A student will not pass or fail just by their performance on the day.

Additional factors considered by the grading panel are:

- Character of student and training regularity/ Length of time training
- The age of the student and any underlying conditions.
- An elementary student is deemed as an attendee of early years classes.
- A junior student is deemed to be a person below sixteen years of age.
- A Senior student is deemed to be a person above sixteen years of age.

Current grading fees include (if successful) a new belt, certificate, and examination.

Any unsuccessful grading may be re-attempted at the next club grading session free of charge.

Grading Scoring Criteria

A student must achieve a minimum of C in all categories to achieve their next belt.

- Excellent all A pass = BMABA OUTSTANDING GOLD SEAL on Certificate
- All A passes in categories = BMABA GOLD SEAL on Certificate
- 1 x B or C but all other categories A = BMABA SILVER SEAL on Certificate
- 2 x B or C but all other categories A = BMABA BRONZE SEAL on Certificate
- 3 x B or C or more passes in any categories = BMABA RED SEAL on Certificate

Grading fees:

White belt to Black with a White stripe belt fee - £20.

All Black belt grading fees are - £95.

UKD Black Belt Register grading fee - £20. (This includes entry to the on-line register and certification)

Orange Belt (8 th Kyu)		Minimum of 10 lessons to grade
White with a Green stripe		Minimum of 10 lessons to grade
Green Belt (7 th Kyu)		Minimum of 10 lessons to grade
White with a Blue stripe		Minimum of 10 lessons to grade
Blue Belt (6 th Kyu)		Minimum of 10 lessons to grade
White with a Purple stripe		Minimum of 10 lessons to grade
Purple Belt (5 th Kyu)		Minimum of 10 lessons to grade
White with a Brown stripe (4th Kyu)	Minimum of 20 lessons to grade
Brown Belt (3 rd Kyu)		Minimum of 20 lessons to grade
Brown with a Black stripe (2 nd Kyu	J)	Minimum of 30 lessons to grade
Black with a White stripe (1st Kyu)		Minimum of 30 lessons to grade
Black Belt (1st Dan)		Minimum of 40 lessons to grade
